

## **Atlantic Rotary Club**

## 4 Year University or College Scholarship

The Atlantic Rotary Club will award two (2) \$2,000 Scholarships to graduating Seniors from Atlantic High School that will be attending a four year college or university. To be eligible, students must be enrolled in a four year college or university on or before October 1<sup>st</sup> of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

Alternates will be chosen. If a recipient is not enrolled by October 1<sup>st</sup>, the scholarship will then be awarded to an alternate, provided the alternate meets the aforementioned eligibility requirement. If neither the recipient nor the alternate meets the requirement, the scholarship will revert back to the Atlantic Rotary Club and will not be awarded.

Criteria, <u>listed in order of priority</u>, that will be used in selecting scholarship recipients. (Only complete applications will be reviewed.)

- ♦ Written essay on the Rotary 4-Way Test
- ◆ Participation in school, church, community activities and volunteerism, including leadership positions held
- ◆ Academic performance in high school
- ◆ Description of career plans
- ◆ Financial assistance needed, including work experience
- ◆ Letters of reference (2 required)
