

Atlantic Rotary Club

Community College, Vocational or Technical Institution Scholarship

The Atlantic Rotary Club will award two (2) \$2,000 Scholarship to a graduating Seniors from Atlantic High School that will be attending a Community College, Vocational or Technical Institution. To be eligible, students must be enrolled in the program on or before October 1^{st} of the year in which the scholarship is awarded.

Alternates will be chosen. If a recipient is not enrolled by October 1st, the scholarship will then be awarded to the alternate, provided the alternate meets the aforementioned eligibility requirement. If neither the recipient nor the alternate meets the requirement, the scholarship will revert back to the Atlantic Rotary Club and will not be awarded.

Criteria, <u>listed in order of priority</u>, that will be used in selecting scholarship recipients. (Only complete applications will be reviewed.)

- ♦ Written essay on the Rotary 4-Way Test (maximum length 1 page)
- ◆ Participation in school, church, community activities and volunteerism, including leadership positions held
- Description of career plans
- ◆ Academic performance in high school (HS Transcript required)
- ◆ Financial assistance needed, including work experience
- ◆ Letters of reference (2 required)
